



IV90936: WINDOWS 10 MACHINES CONTINUE TO REPORT PENDING REBOOT

APAR status

Closed as program error.

Error description

Windows 10 machines continue to report pending reboot although the machine has rebooted.

BigFix checks if a reboot is pending controlling some Windows register keys.

Windows 10, after the reboot, does not delete the key `KLM\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\ComponentBasedServicing\RebootPending` but just deletes the value, while Bigfix controls for the key existence.
